

Anytime Singles League Rules

Scheduling Matches

You will receive a list of names, phone numbers, and emails of other players in your division. Initiate a match by simply calling, texting, or emailing other players in your division of when you would like to play a match. Accepting matches, please try to accept all match requests as best as possible. The spirit of the league is to play lots of different opponents within your division

Scoring

Matches consist of 2 full sets, and a 10 point tie-breaker if you split sets.

First Five Matches

The court fees for your first five matches are covered by the registration fee. Please check in at the front desk before the match and let the desk know you are playing an Anytime Singles League match.

Extra Matches

You are encouraged to play more than five matches in this league. If you play an extra match in the league, you may choose to “throw out” one of your losses towards making the playoffs. Example: If you play a total of eight matches; you may “throw out” 3 match results and then take your best 5 results to try to qualify for the playoffs. You may play as many matches as you like – court fees apply after your first 5 matches.

Tennis Balls

Balls will be provided from us for your match and we ask they be returned to the front desk afterwards.

Reporting Scores

The winner is responsible for reporting the score on the [Anytime Singles League Page](#) on our website or you can notify the front desk of their score, whichever is easier for you.

Scoring System to Determine Standings

You Receive:

0 points for a straight set loss

1 points for a split set loss

2 points for a win

3 points for a win versus a player who finishes the league with a .500 winning percentage or better. You will receive 2 points at the time of your win and the 3rd bonus point at the end of the league for each win versus a player with the 500 winning percentage or better. **Your final point total will be the total of your best five matches.**

*The league minimum to qualify for the playoffs is five matches, and of those five matches only two matches may be played against the same opponent.

Playoffs

The top 4 in each division will make the playoffs. There will be a prize for each divisional winner. Remember, your final score is your BEST 5 RESULTS. You are encouraged to play more than 5 matches. There will be a published playoff date for all divisions. If you qualify for the playoffs, but cannot make the playoff finals, then the next place finisher may be asked to play for you.

Tiebreaker

In the case of a tie for a spot in the playoffs, the following tiebreaker procedure will be followed; #1 Head to Head, #2 Fewest Losses, #3 Most Wins, #4 Coin Toss.
