General Information & Policies

Hours of Operation

Monday – Thursday:	8:00 am – 9:00 pm
Friday:	8:00 am – 6:00 pm
Saturday:	8:00 am – 3:30 pm
Sunday:	9:00 am – 3:30 pm

Court Reservations

- A. Members can book a court up to 7 days in advance with a standard reservation.
- B. Members can secure a court reservation up to 8 weeks in an advance with [Block Time](#).
- C. Non-members may be book 1 day in advance. Pre-payment is required for non-member reservations.
- D. Members can request a court on-line by signing into their [MindBody Account](#).
- E. Current indoor court fees are as follows:
 - a. Sept. - April: \$24 per hour
 - b. May - August: \$18 per hour
- F. No charge for the outdoor stadium court.
- G. Ball Machine Reservations are the court rate + \$10. Great for reps and great to do with someone!
- H. Courts must be cancelled a minimum of 24 hours in advance or the person reserving the court is responsible for paying for the court fee.

Private Lessons

- A. Schedule a lesson with the front desk staff by phone or email (frontdesk@shellabergertennis.com).
- B. Coaches and private lesson rates per hour:
 - Klaus Dlabik \$90
 - Coach Rosey \$90
 - Andy Maunders \$75
 - Tom Wallis \$80
 - Victor Avila \$80
 - Eric Rose \$80
 - Macy Rose (*junior pro*) \$65
- C. Private lesson rates are based on 1 person with the pro; if more than 1 person is in the lesson the rate will be an additional \$7 per extra. Thus if a private is \$80 a semi-private is \$87 divided by 2 people. See [Pro Lesson Breakdown](#) for a more detailed breakdown.
- D. Hitting lessons are available with select pros for \$50 per hour. (*No instruction, but good steady ball.*)
- E. Lessons must be cancelled at least 24 hours in advance or the client will be charged for the lesson.

Adult and Junior Programs

- A. In addition to singles, doubles, and private lessons we offer drills, leagues, social mixers, tournaments, instructional classes, a full pro-shop, and much more.
- B. These opportunities are available to both adults and juniors of all ages.

Check-In Policy

- A. Members and guests must register at the front desk before using any of the Tennis Center facilities.
- B. Payment for services will always precede usage of the facility.
- C. Accepted forms of payment include cash, check, or charge (Visa, MasterCard, AMEX, or Discover).

Becoming a Member

- A. Initial contract agreement of 12-months, which can then convert to monthly.
- B. Initiation fee.
- C. Yearly or monthly dues options.

Guests

- A. Guests are limited to 6 visits per year (April 1 – March 30).
- B. The guest fee is \$10 for the first three visits and \$20 for the last three visits each year.
- C. Each day that one comes to Shellabarger and participates in an activity, this counts as a guest visit, unless it is part of a non-member friendly program.
- D. Non-member friendly programs include: Tennis Fundamentals, Junior Strokes, Pee Wee Classes, the Sunday Social, Special Mixers, and Top Dog Doubles. A non-member friendly program is one that a non-member can come to as often as they'd like without it affecting their maximum number of guest visits allowed per year. Early sign-up privileges and prices will vary depending on whether one is a member however.

General

- A. Courtesy and tennis etiquette should be observed at all times. Good sportsmanship and consideration for others is the rule of club play.
- B. While playing tennis we request everyone wear proper tennis attire. Shirts and shoes must be worn at all times, but shoes that leave marks are impermissible.
- C. Smoking is not allowed in the tennis center at any time.
- D. The tennis center may be rented to outside organizations with the approval of the General Manager.
- E. The General Manager, at his discretion, may close the Tennis Center facilities before the established closing time when the facilities are not being used and are not scheduled for use.
- F. Only the Tennis Center teaching staff is allowed to give tennis instruction on the courts unless a special exception is made by the Tennis Director.
- G. We keep lost and found items for 30 days after which they will be discarded.
- H. Children under ten years of age must be accompanied and supervised by an adult member at all times.
- I. Non-tennis playing children are not allowed on tennis courts while parents or guardians are playing.
- J. Pets are not allowed at the Tennis Center at any time.
- K. No skates, skateboards, or bicycles are allowed on the courts.
